



## CNL Report AGM Report 2015/2016 Season



### CROYDON NETBALL LEAGUE

How times flies by and here we are at the end of another great netball season.

We decided not to do Umpire Forums this year, as felt it might be beneficial to do Players Forums. We started with clubs with multiple teams, which proved to be of great benefit to all club members. Before we could complete this, the new rules were announced and decided not to continue with the other clubs and do ones for everyone in the Summer ie one in July and one in September.

Final results for our highly competitive Saturday/Winter League with 49 teams across 6 divisions are available on our website and the Premier Division was won by Coombe.

The Chairman's Knockout Handicap Cup competition came to a very exciting final between Coombe and HS 'A' with HS 'A' winning 65-44.

The Evening League played on Mondays and Thursdays from September to April is a friendly League, which gives new players the chance to get into the game and umpires the chance to get practice for going forward for their C Award test . This is also used for C Award testing and the new pre-assessments. Regrettably teams have had to be reminded of the basis for this League.

We have four rallies throughout the season – Beginning of Season, End of Season, Evening League and Versatility and we have two more to go as of this report.

Some of our clubs have thriving junior sections and this year they have held match dates between themselves throughout the season, in addition to training plus there will be a Tournament on 26<sup>th</sup> June.

HS 'A' went through to the County League play offs and came 2<sup>nd</sup> and we are now waiting for the results of the Regional play offs to see if they will be successful.

The Summer League is due to start the first week of June through to mid July with 45 teams entering.

The annual presentation dinner dance is to be held on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June, where all awards are presented.

AGM is booked for Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June and again all clubs will be asked to sign up for the Code of Conduct.

A very informative First Aid course was held earlier in the year and looking to do another one later in the year.

In conjunction with England Netball we have secured a loan agreement for sunken posts for our central venue and this should be completed within the next couple of months. We are also in talks with them about possible resurfacing and floodlighting and hope these will be successful as this will be of tremendous benefit to all our clubs and also the school.
